# Biography

Caroline Bergeron was born in Quebec in 1975. Her artist name is ARO and represents, in addition to the diminutive of her first name, three words that have always inspired her: authenticity, romanticism and originality. This future creator of emotions grew up in a family of three children. Her father owned and managed many restaurants and her mother, who had multiple sclerosis, was often hospitalized. Her first memory relating to art is arts & crafts and drawing, then a large 4 x 8 foot mural made in high school. From 12 to 16 years old, she made ceramics. Later, she became interested in scrapbooking.

Graduated in administration and marketing from Cégep de Sainte-Foy, she did a minor in management at the École des Hautes Etudes Commerciales de Montréal (HEC), before continuing to the Elite Program of the École d'Entrepreneurship de Beauce. in Saint-Georges-de-Beauce.

It was during a creation workshop at the latter in 2017 that she returned to art, after a career as a restaurant owner. She was at a turning point in her life, personal and professional, where a pressing need for change was felt. She therefore saw this workshop as a revelation. The benefits of art pushed her in another direction. She would later say of this experience that she was then in a spirit of openness conducive to letting life present her with new possibilities.

Caroline Bergeron has always been immersed in administration, management and marketing. She has always enjoyed taking on challenges, both personally and professionally, so it was natural for her to take up the challenge of combining her entrepreneurial know-how with this new passion for art. Since her change of professional orientation, several elements mark her progress, in particular her meeting in 2019 with Michelle Obama, to present one of her paintings in person, and his exhibition in 2018, at the Carrousel du Louvre in Paris. This trip to the City of Lights allowed her to deepen her knowledge of the different artistic movements and significantly improve her work.

After starting her exhibitions in 2017, ARO experimented with various mediums: acrylic, watercolor, alcohol inks, pastel, charcoal, etc. She took drawing lessons, but also advanced courses in the field of artistic career development at an international level with Catherine Orer.

ARO presents personal exhibitions, in particular "The Sum of My Encounters (2018)", "Urgence de Vivre (2018)" and "ParÊtre (2019)", which were decisive exhibitions for her. She participated in group exhibitions which prompted her, very early in her artistic career, to exhibit in Canada, the United States, France and Poland. From her early days in the art world, she won awards and accolades for her work, including a gold medal (2018) and a silver medal (2017). She has been the subject of several articles, reviews and publications in books and trade journals as well as numerous television appearances.

In 2018, she was appraised for the first time by an art expert in Canada and, in 2020, she was appraised by Akoun in France, which confirmed her value on the international contemporary art market. That same year, she entered the museum level in France with a first exhibition in a contemporary art museum (MACVR3D).

Today, the artist is a member of several professional associations: Le Cercle des artistes Peintres et Sculpteurs du Québec (CAPSQ), the Mondial Art Academia, the Regroupement des Artistes en Arts Visuels du Québec (RAAV), the Collectif International d'Artists ArtZoom (CIAAZ), Art X Terra, etc.

In 2021, she can be found in the Artothèque de Montréal.

# **Artist Statement**

ARO eliminates any form of perspective in her works by means of painting in successive layers, an iconic technique of Jackson Pollock, one of her influences. Technics such as dripping and knife work, make up most of her methods, Her dripping and all-over with a knife technics can alternately be found in her work, which sometimes falls at the crossroads between lyrical abstract and geometric abstract. The use of the circle, a recurring symbol for the artist, is used in some works to allow a lyrical abstraction to unite with it. The other notable influence of the artist is Jean-Paul Riopelle.

From the very beginning of her artistic practice, ARO used pure instinct. An ample gesture that expresses feelings and emotions on canvas. She uses work tools that are similar to those of her two favorite artists. Subsequently, her need to immerse herself in the heart of art history enabled her to learn a great deal during her stay in Paris. Other horizons are opening up to her. Her painting takes on amplitude with the exploration of other mediums.

"Each work has its story. I draw inside and share my thoughts, which is inside me."

"Each work has its story. I draw inside myself and share my thoughts, what is inside me", she explains of her work. "It is something personal that becomes universal as we all seek inner peace, happiness, joy, love."

The creation process begins with questioning. It influences the choice of colors, movements, textures, energy that will make her vibrate. ARO conceives her work in the manner of a dance, where each step, each gesture, each movement is imbued on the canvas with color, corresponds exactly to an inner melody with notes, chords, pauses and sighs, expressing a state of mind or a state of being.

In this sense, she is at one with her work. The artistic attitude of ARO's action painting favors the physical act of painting by placing, dripping or projecting color without figurative suggestion. The structure of the painting is therefore the result of the energy and the psyche that animates her body during the act of creation. This ballet of expressed emotions is a testimony of the living body, in action and in motion, at a precise moment in her life.

In the series "Pure", the artist expresses a need for calm, for benevolence. In other series, which she also calls "collections", the artist rather expresses her desire for movement, her boundless energy, her desire to shout to the world her 'joie de vivre' and her enthusiasm. Works that stand out in particular for the richness of their colors.

"Art defines who we are," says the artist. "It helps create discussions and memories. It is a very powerful and unique emotional marker. Art provides a presence in our environment. Art does good. Art provokes emotions. Art can leave people indifferent or, on the contrary, provoke an emotion so intense that tears will rise and there the work and its master will be reunited forever ". For the artist, painting is a laying bare "a way of revealing oneself, of showing one's vulnerability".

"I paint my life and offer my sensitivity. I create without limits, like when you throw yourself into a void without a safety net." Her sources of inspiration are multiple. "My relationship with others influences who I am and the way I create." Reflections on nature or on humans live in her and push her to creation in her studio. "I listen, I let emerge, I try to understand, I make connections."

Painting is a liberation, a letting go. In this process of liberation, there are three distinct acts: being in the moment, fulfilling the need to express yourself, and inspiring people.
